**ORDER APPROVING CESSATION OF MANUAL
CASE DOCKETING AND PROVIDING FOR PAPERLESS
COURTS UTILIZING THE MISSISSIPPI ELECTRONIC COURTS**

On the Court's own motion and pursuant to M.R.C.P. 5 and UCRCCC 1.16, and the Court finding that the Clerk of this Court has implemented the Mississippi Electronic Courts ("MEC") system in the Circuit Court of Choctaw County and further finding that all *civil* pleadings, case files, and all other Court records can be adequately maintained as part of the MEC system:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, as of April 15, 2022, the Clerk of this Court is authorized and directed to cease manual docketing for all *civil* cases. The Clerk is further authorized and directed to begin exclusive use of the MEC system as the official system for *civil* case docketing in the Circuit Courts of Choctaw County and to maintain any and all *civil* books and *civil* dockets utilizing the MEC system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as of April 15, 2022, the Clerk of this Court is authorized and directed to cease the current maintenance of paper files for all MEC *civil* cases, except as required by the Administrative Procedures for the Mississippi Electronic Courts adopted by this Court.
